


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

 Peer facilitated group review sessions with the intent to help students do well in hard classes

 S.I Leaders are students that have already completed and have done well in the course

 The S.I Leaders attend class and complete class assignments, reading, and homework so that they can facilitate the class to the best of their ability

How to get Started with Virtual S.I



- Virtual S.I: requires laptop or tablet with microphone and camera (recommended not to attend on a phone)
- Reliable internet service
- Must participate with your UNCW Zoom account
- Be free of distractions and bring paper, notes, or resources from class to help guide you



Facts about S.I

- Began at the University of Kansas City
- Has expanded to 33 states and 13 other countries
- UNCW students who attend S.I session do significantly better.
- Half grade and a full grade higher compared to students who do not go to S.I
- Less likely to withdraw than other students (19:1 ratio)

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
