Overview

A minor is an approved course of study designed to provide students with an overview of knowledge and add depth to studies at the university.

Minors are between 18-24 credit hours towards graduation.

Minors will be awarded at the same time as the baccalaureate degree.

Minors are not required for graduation, but can complement a degree and be used to reach the 120 credit hour minimum to graduate.

There are no admission requirements for minors.
