

Requirements for a Minor in Economics:

[ECN 221](#), [ECN 222](#), [ECN 324](#) or [ECN 328](#) and 9 additional hours at the 300-400 level. To earn a minor in economics requires completion of 18 hours, including 9 hours of core courses and 9 hours of electives, with a minimum overall quality point average of 2.00 in courses counted for the minor. Business majors are not eligible for a minor in economics.
